Terms and Conditions

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before booking. By purchasing a ticket or attending the event, you agree to be bound by the terms below.

1. About Weston Hospicecare

Weston Hospicecare is a registered charity based in Weston-super-Mare (Charity Number: 900328). We provide specialist palliative care to people in North Somerset and surrounding areas. Each year, the Hospice relies on fundraising and donations to raise approximately 80% of the £6.5 million needed to continue delivering this vital care each year.

All proceeds from the Easter Trail 2026, including ticket sales and on-the-day donations, go directly to Weston Hospicecare.

2. Your Agreement with Us

- By confirming your booking, you agree that these Terms and Conditions form the basis of the contract between you and Weston Hospicecare.
- Participation in the Easter Trail is entirely at your own risk. Weston Hospicecare, Uphill Village Society, and any associated sponsors or volunteers accept no responsibility for:
 - Personal injury or accidents
 - Loss or damage to personal belongings
- Any other loss incurred while attending or taking part in the trail
 - Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, where such liability cannot be excluded by law.

3. Booking and Tickets

- Children's tickets cost £5 per child.
- Accompanying adults attend free of charge.
- Only children with a paid ticket will receive a trail map, clue pack, certificate, and Easter egg (or suitable alternative).
 - Children under 1 year old may attend free of charge but will not receive a trail pack or prize.
- All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult aged 18 or over at all times.
 - Tickets are non-refundable once purchased.

- Tickets are limited and availability on the day cannot be guaranteed.
We strongly recommend booking in advance.
- Once you have completed the booking form, you will receive a confirmation email. Please bring this with you on the day (digital or printed).

4. Event Details

- The Easter Trail takes place on Saturday 4 April 2026
 - The event runs from 10.00am to 2.00pm
 - Last entry to collect trail packs is 12.30pm
 - The start and end point is Uphill Victory Hall
 - The trail route is based in and around Uphill Village and includes residential areas
- Please be considerate of local residents and surroundings at all times.

5. Cancellations and Weather

- The Easter Trail is an outdoor, all-weather event.
- Weston Hospicecare reserves the right to cancel the event at short notice due to adverse weather or other safety concerns.
- In the event of cancellation, we will endeavour to notify participants using the contact details provided at booking and update our website and social media channels as soon as possible.
 - Tickets are non-refundable, including if you are unable to attend.
- If the event is cancelled and you have purchased a child ticket, you may contact Maisy Bartlett (Community Fundraiser) at maisy.bartlett@westonhospicecare.org.uk to arrange collection of your child's Easter egg prize.

6. Safety and Personal Responsibility

- Risk assessments have been carried out; however, the trail may include uneven, cobbled, muddy, or slippery surfaces.
 - Participants are advised to wear appropriate clothing and sensible footwear.
- Weston Hospicecare cannot be held responsible for trips, slips, or falls.
- We reserve the right to refuse entry or remove anyone from the event who behaves in a manner that is unsafe, disruptive, or inappropriate.
- The Easter Trail is a family-focused event. Adults are only permitted to take part when accompanying a child under the age of 16.
 - Unaccompanied adults are not permitted to participate.

7. Accessibility and Assistance

- The trail is largely flat and suitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs, though some paths may be narrow.

- Registered assistance dogs are welcome.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and are not permitted inside Uphill Victory Hall (Guide dogs are permitted inside the Victory Hall).

- Dairy-free or non-chocolate alternatives for children's prizes can be provided if notified at the time of booking.

- If you or your child does not wish to be photographed, please inform a member of staff or a photographer on the day.

- Professional photography is not permitted without prior agreement.
 - By attending the event, you consent to the use of images taken unless you have explicitly opted out.
